Please carefully read the adoption conditions below before signing this contract.

1. The dog must be fed, watered and maintained in good condition at all times. This includes regular exercise and health checks.
2. The dog must live in the home as part of the family. He/she must not be kept outside alone for any length of time and must never be made to sleep outside.
3. If the dog appears ill or injured you must seek timely advice from a qualified veterinary surgeon.
4. Under NO circumstances may this dog be used for breeding. It is our usual policy to spay/castrate all dogs prior to adoption, however this is not always possible. If an entire male is adopted he must be neutered by 18 months of age or at full sexual maturity, whichever comes soonest. If an entire female is adopted she must be spayed 10-12 weeks after the end of her next season. If an entire female comes into season post adoption she MUST NOT be allowed to come into contact with any other dogs during this time.

You agree to arrange castration/spay on or around Not Applicable. On receipt of proof of surgery and proof of cost the rescue will reimburse the cost of neutering surgery up to a maximum of £300.

5. The dog must wear a collar with ID tag at all times outside the house.
6. The dog must be given appropriate outdoor exercise and not left home alone for longer than 4 hours per day at any one time.
7. You must comply with all the legal requirements of dog ownership according to the laws of England and Wales (or the laws of Scotland if the dog's new home is in Scotland) and, in particular, you must ensure the dog is always kept under proper control as determined by section 3 of the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991 (<https://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukpga/1991/65/section/3>).

8. If the dog displays behavioural problems post-adoption you must notify the rescue and, where appropriate, seek advice from a qualified dog trainer/behaviourist. (You may contact the rescue for information on behaviourists).
9. You must ensure the dog's microchip always reflects your current contact information (you can update your details with the microchip company online – contact the rescue for help if needed). Please inform the rescue if you change your address and/or telephone number.
10. A non-refundable adoption fee of £300 is payable at the time of adoption (this may be reduced at the rescue's discretion, e.g. for older dogs). The rescue relies entirely on donations and all monies received go towards vet fees, kennelling, feeding etc. The adoption fee can be paid via bank transfer, online via our website or in cash/cheque.
11. You will allow a representative of Boxer Dog Rescue Northern England to visit your home at any reasonable time to inspect the dog post adoption.
12. If we find the dog is being mistreated in any way he/she will be removed from the home immediately and legal action may be taken.
13. We reserve the right to remove the dog from your care if we believe that you have violated any of the conditions in this contract.
